Dear Partner:

I'm writing you today because on August 2nd Missouri voters will head to the polls in our state's primary election. As you know, your union is an advocate for you not only in your workplace, but also in the halls of our state capitol.

We believe our elected leaders should support strong unions, safe workplaces, and good wages and benefits for ALL workers. That's why we've chosen to endorse candidates of both political parties based on their positions on these issues.

Our records indicate that you live in a senate district where we have Republican candidates that are pro-worker. All of these candidates have competitive primaries, and we feel it's our responsibility to let you know which of these candidates will support not just labor unions, but non-union workers as well.

Nate Tate is running for the state senate in your district. He has demonstrated a clear and undeniable pro-worker position on a number of topics and will fight for workers in the state senate.
